New Law Effective August 6, 2019 Brianna's Law signed by Governor Andrew Cuomo

- Under a new law known as Brianna's Law, all powerboat operators:
 - Born on or after January 1, 1993 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in January 2020.
 - Born on or after January 1, 1988 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in January 2022.
 - Born on or after January 1, 1983 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in January 2023.
 - Born on or after January 1, 1978 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in January 2024.
 - All motor boat operators regardless of age will need a boating safety certificate beginning in January 2025
- Operators may not operate a Personal Watercraft (Jet Ski) unless they are at least 14 years of age and hold a boater safety certificate; Operators **MUST** be certified regardless of age. If you were born on or after May 1, 1996 you currently need a boating safety certificate to operate a powerboat as well.
- Students must be at least 10 years of age to attend the course.

- ❖ This 8-hour Certificate Course Will Teach You the Basics You Need to Know for Boating and Operating a Personal Watercraft. This course is **mandatory** for all Personal Watercraft (Jet Ski) operators and for boating in NY/NJ waters.
